The Hill Family Estate has 11 different vineyards spread out through Napa Valley with a combined 250 Acres. For years the Hill Family has grown for names like: Silver Oak, Duckhorn & Stag's Leap. Local pro surfer and sommelier Kyle Knox collaborated with Hill Family to produce this jammy, blackberry earthy Merlot Cabernet blend.



Mount Veeder Winery

Resembling a giant staircase, Mount Veeder's vines are planted on wide terraces of earth cut into steep slopes.

At elevations of 1,000 to 1,600 feet rugged mountain conditions produce grapes with intensely concentrated fruit and big, rich tannins. Mount Veeder winery grapes are handled as little as possible, using tested techniques to bring out the concentration and power that mountain grapes reveal.

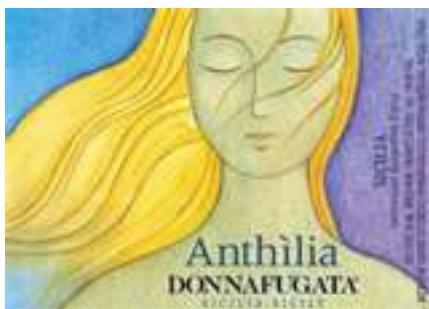

The 2009 Anthilia is a fresh, perfumed Sicillian offering laced with juicy white peaches, jasmine, grapefruit and mint. This tasty, crisp white is an ideal summer time or aperitif wine, and will be at its best over the next year or two. Anthilia is a blend of Catarratto, Ansonica and other indigenous grapes.



Winery construction was completed 1981 and was used primarily for champagne production through the late 1980's. In the early 1990's the winery began producing high quality red and white varietals. Today Fallbrook Winery is one of the leaders in California's emerging South Coast wine region. The winery consists of 36 acres resting between the Pacific Coast and the Pala- Mesa Mountains. A climate characterized by consistent and moderate temperatures throug-out the growing season with warm days and cool nights. These conditions allow for the grapes to develop the optimal sugar & acid levels needed to create a very flavorful and balanced wine. Our two favorites: BDX Meritage and Sauvignon Blanc
